## Fractions, Decimals, and Percents: Coming Together for Understanding

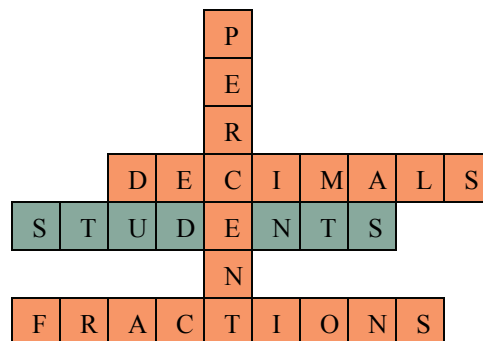
